POSITION OVERVIEW

The Pastor of Discipleship is committed to the vision of making disciples within the church according to the biblical mandate. He/she will oversee the development and implementation of purposeful discipleship throughout the ministries of the Cantonese-speaking congregation.

He/she is responsible for providing leadership, resources, and programs to promote a culture of discipleship growth through personal spiritual disciplines among the church members.

He/she will work with other Cantonese Ministry pastoral team, deacons and lay leaders collaboratively in a team approach to holistically minister and support the discipleship of the Cantonese-speaking congregation.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Discipleship and Spiritual Formation:

- In partnership with the Cantonese Ministry Charge Pastor, articulate a clear and consistent understanding of discipleship that aligns with the culture and mission of Cantonese Ministry
- Develop, implement and maintain comprehensive discipleship strategies and programs to lead the body into greater spiritual maturity
- Ensure integration and alignment between all discipleship strategies and programs so that ministry leaders work in collaboration and partnership towards a shared strategic vision
- Create and develop a life-on-life discipleship/mentorship program within the congregation
- Oversee ongoing training and development for new and existing Fellowship leaders and Sunday School teachers
- Curriculum and resource management for the Fellowship and Nurture ministries
- Assess areas of need for discipleship training and plan appropriate development of spiritual growth
- Build and deploy a discipleship ministry core team.

- Develop metrics and methods for measuring transformation in the Cantonese-speaking congregation each year

Fellowship Ministry:

- Provide pastoral leadership and direction on one or more of the fellowships assigned in SCBC
- In collaboration with the lay leadership team, create, implement, and manage overall vision and strategy to grow, engage, empower and reach the fellowships leaders
- Develop and execute systems of leadership development and management that shape the culture and raise the leadership bar for the fellowships assigned

General Pastoral Responsibilities

- Participate in general pastoral duties such as preaching, teaching, and other leadership roles as assigned by the Cantonese Ministry Charge Pastor.
- Provide clear communication with regards to ministry progress, results, and obstacles to the Cantonese Ministry Charge Pastor and the Cantonese Pastoral Team
- Assist in the development of annual budgets for his/her areas of responsibility with the input of his/her ministry team(s)
- Co-work with the Outreach Pastor and the Cantonese Ministry pastoral team to provide leadership in reaching out to the community
- Be flexible to expand or be reassigned by Charge Pastor to other responsibilities over time
- Collaborate and work closely with current lay leaders in building up a Christ-centered, Scriptural-based church community of vibrant faith, hope and love
- Work and collaborate with the current Cantonese Ministry pastoral team to provide pastoral care and shepherd an Cantonese-speaking congregation of 800+ worshippers
- Join the current SCBC pastoral staff in serving a multi-lingual, multi-cultural and multi-generational evangelical church of 1,500+ regular Sunday attendance
